

## JASON BATH SYSTEM CLEANER DIRECTIONS OF USE

*The following are the recommended directions that are provided on our Jason Bath System Cleaner Bottle. This solution cleans the bath surface and the various parts of your bath system that you can't physically reach. Use at least once a month to keep your bath sparkling clean.*

### Whirlpool, MicroSilk<sup>®</sup> and MicroSilk<sup>®</sup>-Whirlpool Baths

#### Directions:

- 1) Close bath drain and open air controls.
- 2) Fill bath with warm water to a level at least 2" (5cm) above the highest jet.
- 3) Pour 16 ounces (entire container) into the bath water.
- 4) Turn on pump for 10 minutes.
- 5) Turn off pump and drain the bath.
- 6) To rinse, refill the bath with cold water, turn on pump for five minutes, then turn off pump and drain the bath. Your bath system is now clean!

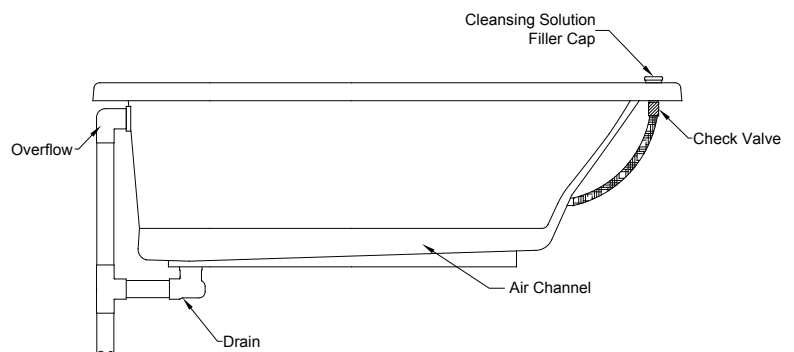
**Disinfection:** To disinfect your bath, household bleach can be added to the bath water with this solution. For one person baths with capacities of up to 50 gallons (190 liters), add one cup (8 fluid ounces or 236 ml) of household bleach. For two-person baths with capacities greater than 50 gallons, add two cups (16 fluid ounces or 473 ml) of household bleach. DO NOT APPLY full strength bleach or other chlorinated cleansers directly to metal bath trim or faucetry.

**Caution:** Avoid contact with eyes. In case of eye contact, flush with water for several minutes. If taken internally, drink plenty of water, induce vomiting, then see a physician.

### AirMasseur<sup>®</sup> Baths

#### Directions:

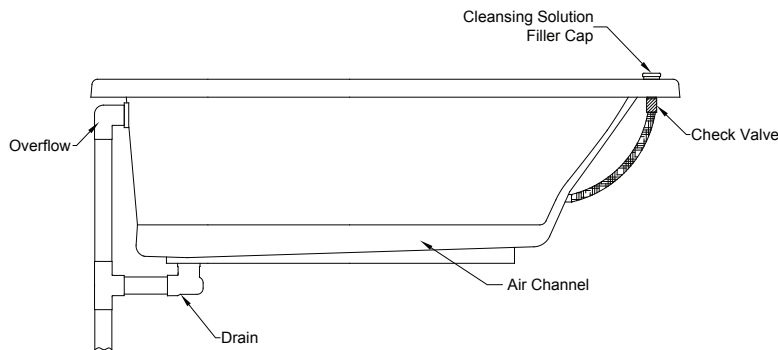
- 1) Close the drain and remove cleansing solution filler cap, located on the bath deck.
- 2) Pour all of the Jason Bath System Cleaner (16 oz.) into the dispenser, following the directions on the bottle, and replace the cap. Bleach may also be added as indicated on the bottle.
- 3) Fill bath with warm water to approximately 4" above the air inlet holes.
- 4) After 10 minutes, turn on the bath blower for (1 - 2) minutes.
- 5) Turn blower off and allow cleaner solution to soak for an additional (10) minutes. While soaking, the solution in bath may be used to wash inside of the bath. Use rubber gloves and sponge if bleach is used.
- 6) Drain the bath.
- 7) Rinse by refilling the bath with cold water to approximately 4" above the air inlet holes and then drain the bath.



# Air-Whirlpool and MicroSilk®-AirMasseur® Baths

## Directions:

- 1) Close the drain and remove cleansing solution filler cap, located on the bath deck.
- 2) Pour all of the Jason Bath System Cleaner (16 oz.) into the dispenser, following the directions on the bottle, and replace the cap. Bleach may also be added as indicated on the bottle.
- 3) Fill bath with warm water to approximately 4" above the air inlet holes.
- 4) After 10 minutes, fill bath to 2" above highest jet.
- 5) Turn on both the air blower and pump for 10 minutes.
- 6) Drain the bath.
- 7) Rinse by refilling the bath with cold water to approximately 2" above the highest jet, run air blower and pump for one minute and then drain the bath.



# AirMasseur® Baths and Integrity Air-Baths (First Generation)

## Directions:

- 1) Close the drain and fill bath with warm water to approximately 4" above the air inlet holes.
- 2) Pour all of the Jason Bath System Cleaner (16 oz.) into the bath, in accordance with the directions on the bottle. Bleach may also be added as indicated on the bottle.
- 3) Turn on the bath blower for (1 - 2) minutes.
- 4) Turn blower off and allow cleaner solution to soak for (15) minutes. While soaking, the solution in bath may be used to wash inside of the bath. Use rubber gloves and sponge if bleach is used.
- 5) Drain the bath.
- 6) Rinse by refilling the bath with cold water to approximately 4" above the air inlet holes and then drain the bath.
